## Strong matric results across SACAI, IEB & British International

We're pleased to share the exceptional achievements of Teneo's Class of 2025.

---

### Leading the way in academic excellence

Teneo reported an **80% overall pass rate** with **892 Teneo learners** **successfully completing their 2025 NSC matric exams**, bringing the **total number of Teneo School graduates** to date to **over 4 000 matriculants**.


Across both the South African Comprehensive Assessment Institute (SACAI) and the Independent Examinations Board (IEB), **Teneo learners achieved outstanding results:**

- **406 distinctions across SACAI and IEB**, representing a **22% increase in the number of distinctions** per matriculant compared to 2024.
- **Overall pass rate of 80%** for all Teneo 2025 matriculants.
- In the SACAI stream, Teneo learners achieved an **8% higher pass rate** than the national average SACAI pass rate of 73%, as well as **8% more Bachelor Passes** than the average of all institutions registered with SACAI.
- In the IEB stream, learners achieved an **86% increase in distinctions per matriculant compared to 2024**.
- **90% of Teneo's matriculants qualified for tertiary studies.**
